Ricardo H.M. Godoi, Ph.D., Professor

Ricardo Henrique Moreton Godoi has BS in Chemistry (1993), Master of Science and Doctor of Physical-Chemistry from São Paulo State University (2000), and post-doctorate in Environmental Chemistry at University of Antwerp, Belgium (2001-2005). He is currently a Professor in Environmental Engineering at Federal University of Paraná. Assessment is co-responsible for the subjects Brazilian Antarctic Program – Aerosol. His main topics of research are the study of effect of air pollution to the human health; the relation between air pollution and the cultural heritage; aerosols in remote areas and their influence on the global climate.
