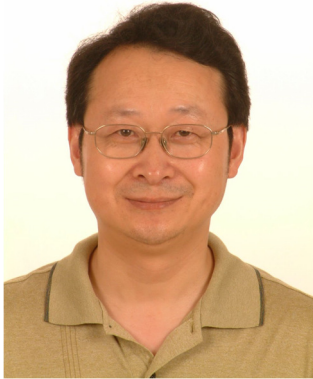


Zheng Zheng, Professor

As the principle investigator, Professor Zheng presided over the 863 project “Countryside Sewage Treatment Technologies and Project Demonstration” and the 863 sub-project “Study on Biodiversity Construction Technologies at the Riparian Zone” during the 10th “five-year plan” period, and the 863 Lake Tai Project “Watershed Pollution Control Technologies and Project Demonstration at Wujingang – a Lake Tai’s Tributary with Complex Pollution Sources” during the 11th “five-year plan” period. Now, during the 12th “five-year plan” period, Professor Zheng has participated in the draft of key water pollution prevention and control program outline by the Ministry of Housing and Urban-Rural Development and Ministry of Environmental Protection. Up to date, Professor Zheng has finished four China’s Natural Science Foundation projects, and more than 20 provincial and ministerial projects. He has been awarded National Second Prize for Advancement in Science and Technology, and six other provincial and ministerial prizes for Advancement in Science and Technology. He has published more than 30 SCI papers, 116 Chinese Core Journal articles, and 2 books. He has also applied for 2 international patents, and got more than 40 national invention patents.

Professor Zheng’s research team has 36 members, including 4 professors, 3 associate professors, 3 lecturers, 4 post-docs, 10 doctoral students, and 12 master students.
