Poster Session Presentation

Presentation of a paper in a poster session provides an opportunity for a more personal question and answer session, as well as more one-to-one communication, and effective visual display for your material.

- A. The session structure allows each poster paper to be viewed for an extended period, while the author(s) is available to give an oral presentation and to answer questions for the scheduled period.
- B. Set-up time is allowed for each presentation to be mounted on a single 4' x 6' (120 cm x 180 cm) bulletin board before the start of the session. It is highly advisable to bring your own thumb tacks or push pins with you; the AAS can only provide a very limited supply of mounting materials.
- C. Proper illustration is essential to an effective poster presentation. The use of large lettering (legible at a distance of 3 feet or more) and minimal textual material is recommended. Use of a colored ink in printing and colored paper in framing textual material can be attractive, but excessive artistic flair should be avoided. Illustrations should not be printed on heavy stock because this makes them more difficult to mount securely on poster boards.
- D. Presentation of information should follow a logical sequence as it does in the paper, i.e. introduction, results, conclusion, etc. Be sure to include a proper title at the top of the poster.
- E. Collection of poster materials at the end of the session is the presenting author's responsibility.
- F. Poster sessions are scheduled as follows:
 - Poster (I): January 23, 6:30-8:30 p.m.
 - Poster (II): January 24, 6:30-8:30 p.m.
